



4010 Peas

4010 Peas are a purple flower spring pea and can be planted in either spring or fall. Grows best in cooler climates. High-protein forage for grazing or haylage/baleage, but supplement with hay or plant in a mix with oats, spring triticale, or spring barley for added effective fiber and a slower rate of passage. Alone, the feed value is comparable to alfalfa haylage. Large leaves and excellent palatability.

Cutting Management

If planted with a small grain, harvest when the grain is at boot stage for best quality. Otherwise, harvest at flowering. Pea grain can also be harvested and ground to replace protein like soybean meal.
