Revised Formula:

Highland Hay

Seeding Rate: 25lb/A

50% PLH resistant alfalfas

25% Soft leaf tall fescues

25% Orchardgrass

A blend of two OC coated Potato Leaf Hopper resistant alfalfas, mixed with Soft Leaf Tall Fescues and Orchardgrass. Well suited for hard to get to fields or management that does not include a leaf hopper spray application.

Highland Hay makes for excellent mixed auction hay that will feed quite well.

Area of Adaptation:

USDA Hardiness Zones: 6 & 7a

Good to dryer soils

Wet- Tall fescue will dominate in wet areas. Alfalfa does not tolerate wet soils well.

Drought—Very good.

pH range: 6.0 and higher.

Cutting Management:

Cut leaving a 3-4 in" stubble height. Orchardgrass yields, regrowth and persistence will decrease with short cuttings. Do no cut short.

Stand life:

With good management and proper soils, alfalfa should last a minimum of 3 years. Consistent early harvest of alfalfa will shorten alfalfa stand life. For longer alfalfa stand life delay fall harvest to full flower, which replenishes alfalfa root energy reserves.

Traffic Tolerance:

Adequate. The Tall Fescue has excellent traffic tolerance.
