## Hay Mix

**Seeding Rate: 25lb/A**

- 65%** KingFisher alfalfa
- 8%** Liherold Meadow fescue
- 8%** Perseus Festulolium
- 7%** Fojtan Festulolium
- 6%** White Clover
- 6%** Red Clover

*NutraMax is a highly digestible alfalfa, clover and grass mix that is primarily adapted to central PA and north. Its best use is haylage and baleage as it will dry a little slow for dry hay. Both protein and energy levels are superb.*

*This mix was developed by a top-end dairy nutritionist over the course of several years.*

### Area of Adaptation:

USDA Hardiness Zones: 4 & 5  
Best on well-drained soils, but will tolerate variable soils.  
Wet: Alfalfa does not tolerate wet soil well  
Drought: very good.  
pH range: Alfalfa prefers 6.5 or higher

### Cutting Management:

Cut leaving a 3-4 inch stubble height.

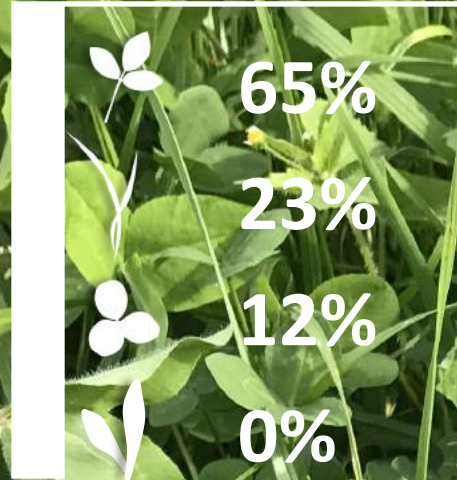
### Stand life:

Approximately 3-4 years with good management practices. To extend alfalfa stand life, wait until full flowering for fall harvest to replenish root reserve.

### Traffic Tolerance:

Adequate. The grasses have good traffic tolerance, but alfalfa's traffic tolerance is poorer.

Intensive Grazing: Good but high protein leads to bloat potential  
Continuous Grazing: Poor

Depth: 1/8-3/8 inch
