NurtraMax is a highly digestible alfalfa, clover and grass mix that is primarily adapted to central PA and north. Its best use is haylage and baleage as it will dry a little slow for dry hay. Both protein and energy levels are superb.

This mix was developed by a top-end dairy nutritionist over the course of several years.

Area of Adaptation:

USDA Hardiness Zones: 4 & 5

Best on well-drained soils, but will tolerate variable soils.

Wet: Alfalfa does not tolerate wet soil well

Drought: very good.

pH range: Alfalfa prefers 6.5 or higher

Cutting Management:

Cut leaving a 3-4 inch stubble height.

Stand life:

Approximately 3-4 years with good management practices. To extend alfalfa stand life, wait until full flowering for fall harvest to replenish root reserve.

Traffic Tolerance:

Adequate. The grasses have good traffic tolerance, but alfalfa's traffic tolerance is poorer.
