# Early blooming variety

Annual forage plant. Slightly hairy but still palatable to livestock because of high protein content. Can be sown alone or in pasture mixtures.

## Technical Characteristics:

## Agronomic Characteristics

Early blooming erect. The production of leafy matter is substantial and the reddish purple flower, rather elongated, appears during the first ten days of May. It grows adequately in acid soils but it adapts well to different types of soils, even dy and less fertile ones.

### Sowing:

Autumn or spring with 20-25 lb/Acre

#### Production:

Forage production usually achieves 10-14 tons / acre of fresh product. If planted with other legumes or grasses, production increases in quality and quantity.

#### Tolerance:

Withstands front and fungus infections
