

Fiber Pro 50

A dwarf BMR variety that is the shortest maturity in the lineup: 85-90 days. Can be direct chopped in soft dough stage OR harvested in a cut and wilt system following frost. The dwarf characteristic helps reduce lodging and improves the leaf: stem ratio, further increasing digestibility.

Field Positioning:

Prefers drier soils, requires 30-35% less water than corn silage and has excellent drought stress tolerance. Performs well on less productive soils.

Target Harvest Timing:

Soft Dough OR cut/wilt at boot stage.

If cutting direct, prior to soft dough stage, increase cutting length to maximum length and use a homolactic silage preservative.
