

Leafy T Pearl Millet

Leafy T is known for its wide leaf characteristics. This dwarf variety has good disease resistance and seedling vigor.

Establishment:

This small seed should be broadcasted or drilled very shallow. Seed only when moisture is immediately available, shallow plantings are more susceptible to immediate temperature and moisture changes. Calibrate the spreader or drill for best results. If broadcasting, ensure that there is little residue in the way of the seed getting contact with the soil.

Harvest Management:

Wait until forage reaches at least 18 inches to graze or cut. For best quality and yield, cut when height reaches 24-36 inches. Leave 6 inches of stubble when cutting for fastest regrowth. Condition with a crimper at a slight diagonal to speed drying. Wilt to 60-68 % moisture for storage in bunker or concrete stave silo, 55-65% for a sealed storage system.

Harvest Height:

Grazing—18-24 inches
Hay/Haylage—36 -40 inches
Greenchop—36-40 inches

At A Glance:

Best Use—haylage and green chop

Establishment—

Plant after soils are 65 degrees and rising

1/4-1/2"
