Seeding Rate: 20-30lb/A

60% *Cajun II Endophyte Free Tall Fescue that persists well in the south.*

25% *Persist NP (CT Coated) Orchardgrass with good grazing tolerance and southern persistence.*

15% *Olathe UT- A very strong, early orchard grass with excellent disease resistance & improved quality.*

When quality, durability, and cost matters. This all grass mix is designed for zones 6b to 7b making it an ideal fit for VA, MD, DE and Southeastern PA.

Southern Brawn provides the diversity you need in a hayfield or pasture while giving you the option of broadleaf weed control during the establishment year. After establishment, frost-seeding a clover or clover blend into the stand in late winter can be a great option to thicken the stand and further boost protein.

Wet- Good, Tall Fescue will dominate in wet

pH range: 6.0 and higher.

Cutting Management:

Cut leaving a 3-4 in" stubble height.

Stand life:

A long lived mix, should persist for 5-10 years.
