

King's Rye-Winter Pea Mix

A simple mix that has soil health benefits that can be planted later than most other annual grass legume mixes. Cereal Rye is the most adapted small grain for later planting and Keystone Winter Pea has been a very strong late planted winter pea as it establishes quickly as a winter pea. This mix can also be used for forage.

Soil Adaptation

Best used on well drained soils

Adapted to light to heavy soil textures

pH Range -6.0 to 7.5

Note: Allow peas to mature for full benefit potential.

Formulation:

60% VNS Rye

40% Keystone Winter Pea

Establishment:

Planting Dates: Winter barley through late wheat planting dates

Seeding Rate: 60 to 90 lb/A planted for cover crop (increase rate as seeding date gets later)

100 to 120 lb/A planted for forage

Depth: 1.25 to 2.0"

Speed: Establishes quickly
