Lavina Spring Barley is a 2 row awnless forage type barley. Selected for it's height making it yield well for bailing and silage. Lavina should be harvested at medium dough stage for best forage quality and yield. Good regrowth.

Planting Dates: Barley to Mid Wheat Dates

Seeding Rate: Forage: 125-150lbs/Acre

Cover Crop: 50-75lbs/Acre (increase with later plantings)

Seeding Depth: 3/4" - 1 1/2"
