Winter Pea

WyoWinter winter pea is selected out of the Austrian winter pea for improved winter hardiness. This pea was developed by the University of Wyoming. WyoWinter has a yellow cotyledon and produces purple flowers. It is ideal for forage production, wildlife, feed grain and cover cropping. This pea is well adapted across the U.S. and shows excellent winter hardiness.

For best performance, please inoculate.
